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## Code of Ethics to be followed by IPV (Proficiency Testing)Participants:

Successful Participant Laboratories in Meena's Proficiency Testing (IPV) Scheme must understand that the following Code of Ethics shall guide the actions of the Participant Organizations certified under the IPV Scheme:

- 1. To uphold at all times the reputation of the Scheme and the dignity of membership therein.
- 2. To pursue their professional discipline and activities in a spirit of fairness to all concerned employer, employees, customers and competitors consistent with the high ideals of personal honour and integrity.
- 3. To refrain from associating themselves with any enterprise that would use their name or that of the Scheme in any manner tolerating misrepresentation.
- 4. To avoid damage directly or indirectly to the professional reputation, prospects or business of another member of the Scheme
- 5. To inform clients or employers of any business affiliations, interests or connections which might influence their fair judgment.
- 6. Perform their professional duties with proper regard for the physical environment and the safety, health and well-being of the public.
- 7. To encourage and provide opportunity for professional development and advancement of their employees or those under their direct supervision.
- 8. To avoid conflict of interests with the employer and/or contractor where possible, if it is unavoidable, disclose the same to the employer or contractor in advance.
- 9. To maintain their proficiency by updating their technical knowledge as required to properly practice NDT in the method the participant laboratory is authorized to.
- 10. To inform at the earliest to MIMeena International LLP any attempt to pressure or force an organization certified under the IPV Scheme to violate this code of ethics
- 11. To contribute to the advancement of NDT Community by the interchange of information and experience with others.
- 12. To inform relevant competent authorities immediately if their IPV certificate is suspended, withdrawn or cancelled.
- 13. To undertake only those NDT assignments for which they are competent by virtue of their participation in a PT Scheme and Certification.
- 14. To sign documents only for the work in which they have professional knowledge and/or have supervisory control.
- 15. To comply with all the above Code of Ethics.
